





Positioning itself as 'probably the best gin \$ per ml on the market', Hawthorn's superb value London Dry Gin offers all the quality and authentic back story expected of a craft expression for the price of far more mainstream competitors. Despite launching as recently as 2014, the brand's strong commercial appeal has already won it widespread US distribution as well as major listings at home in the UK.

Hawthorn's was created by Will Turnage as a tribute to his grandfather, a commander in the British Navy during the Second World War who survived being sunk three times. His safe return to port would always be celebrated with a gin toast served 'on the rocks' and the commander would regularly invite his fellow officers to raise a glass of gin to toast 'the future', a tradition that Hawthorn's has revived today.

The gin itself is based on a 200-year old recipe and takes inspiration from the British countryside using 100% English wheat spirit with the addition of 10 botanicals, including nutmeg from Sri Lanka and cassia bark from Indonesia. Single batch production takes place in a vintage copper pot still made by the acclaimed John Dore & Co.
